3 x 2 mile relay

Thursday, 11th July 2013, 7:30pm

- Three stage relay around the picturesque setting of Dearnford Lake. Stages are approximately two miles on a traffic-free multi-terrain course, including parkland and woodland tracks.
- Teams made up of three runners representing running or athletic clubs, groups of family or friends, work colleagues and other clubs.
- Prizes for fastest male and female individual legs. Also prizes for winning team in each category.
- Race HQ, start and finish at Dearnford Lake, Whitchurch, Shropshire, SY13 3JQ.
- Facilities include toilets, ample car parking and a café with food and drinks available. No showers or changing facilities are available at the venue.
- Entry is limited to 200 teams. Early entries would be appreciated. Entries will be accepted on the night subject to a £2 surcharge. All team registrations must be completed before 7pm.

The information provided by you on this form will be used solely for the purpose of race results and identification for health and safety reasons. It will only be available to the results team and appropriate race officials, and will be passed to UKA bodies for official purposes only.

Additional event and competitor information

Whitchurch Whippets hope that you can enter a team into our event and we look forward to seeing you at the Dearnford Lake Relay. To help the event run smoothly, we have included some additional information below.

Entries and eligibility

- Teams can only be eligible for one category. All runners must be aged 15 or over on race day.
- Runners are not permitted to complete more than one leg or enter in more than one team.
- Changes to teams or running order are permitted on the night. However all team registrations and changes must be submitted before 7pm on race day.
- Mixed teams (Senior or Junior) may consist of either 1 male and 2 female runners or 2 male and 1 female runner.
- All athletes aged 17 and under on the day of the race are considered "Juniors" for team and award purposes
- All runners in a Mixed Junior team must be aged 17 and under on the day
- Junior runners may run in senior teams
- If a Junior runs the fastest leg of the day he/she will be awarded both the Open and Junior fastest Leg Awards
- Community teams may consist of members from the same place of work, non-running club, family or friends, but must not contain more than one affiliated runner or member of a running/athletic club. Mixed gender teams are permitted.
- Whitchurch Whippets welcomes entries from disabled athletes. To ensure that an adequate risk assessment is made,
 disabled athletes should contact a member of the organising committee well in advance of the race to discuss any
 specific requirements and ensure they can be accommodated safely. The course is unsuitable for wheelchairs due to
 the rugged nature of some parts of the course and narrow woodland paths.

Event location

- Dearnford Lake is located just off the Tilstock Road (B5476), south of Whitchurch and is easily found by following the brown tourist signs for Dearnford Lake. The postcode for Dearnford Lake is SY13 3JQ. Please visit www.dearnford.com for further information.
- Due to open water at the venue, all children must be supervised by a responsible adult during the whole event.
